centre, public open space, gypsy and traveler pitches plus the realignment of the B480. The emerging proposal also includes significant associated highway infrastructure as well as the provision of a runway.

West Sussex County Council (WSCC) & Lovell Joint Venture – Daniel is part of a team acting for WSCC and Lovell in relation to several key portfolio sites within Arun and Crawley. Each of the sites are being brought forward for residential-led redevelopment and comprise a mix of allocated previously developed land and unallocated sites which present the opportunity for sensitive extension to existing settlements.

Bracknell Beeches Business Park, Bracknell – Daniel is part of a team acting for S2 Estates in relation to the redevelopment of Bracknell Beeches Business Park. The residential-led redevelopment of the site seeks to deliver 349 new homes and flexible commercial/community floorspace across 7 buildings ranging from 4 to 16 storeys. Alongside new homes the scheme will also deliver a new public square, comprehensive landscaping and a new southern access to Bracknell Railway Station. The scheme received a resolution to grant at committee in July 2022.
