In environmental planning, she undertook extensive environmental constraint analysis for a range of sites, assisting in the preparation of EIA Screening Opinion Requests, Scoping Reports, Preliminary Environmental Impact Reports, and Environmental Statements for both mixed-use TCPA and renewable energy DCO projects.

In infrastructure planning, Alice has developed a good understanding of the DCO process through assisting in the pre-application stage for both TCPA and DCO infrastructure projects. She has also completed extensive site research and policy analysis for a range of sites, including working with clients Great British Energy – Nuclear.

Greenwich Peninsula - Following the grant of outline planning permission for the mixed-use redevelopment of land at Greenwich Peninsula, Alice has been involved in the coordination and submission of several planning condition discharges to enable the commencement of development.
